ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above Government have issued orders for the unification of the date of retirement of Government employees as 31st March every year without affecting the new recruitment at the relevant entry cadre. In order to ensure that new recruitments are not affected, Government have also decided to fill up vacancies at the entry level, that would have arisen but for this unification, against the supernumerary posts to be created for this purpose and orders have been issued as per the GO read as 2nd paper above and as per the circular read as 3rd paper above.

In order to create supernumerary posts in State Water Transport Department, Director State Water Transport Department has submitted proposals vide letters read as 4th paper above. There is a total 60 retirement vacancies in State Water Transport Department for the period from 1.4.09 to 31.3.2010., out of which 39 posts have to be reported to Kerala Public Service commission as supernumerary posts and rest of the vacancies have to be filled up by promotion from the feeder categories as per the existing Special rules. As per the report of the State Water Transport Department the following posts have to be created as supernumerary posts in State Water Transport Department

1. Boat Lascar	-	7
2. Boat Driver	-	5
3. Boat Syrang	-	9
4. Boat Master	-	11
5. Fitter Grade II	-	1
6. Carpenter	-	2
7. L.D. Clerk	-	3
8. Peon	-	1
