ORDER

In the letter read as 1st paper above, Government of India have referred to approval of Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) for its implementation in the country from Kharif 2016 season in place of National Agricultural Insurance Scheme (NAIS) and Modified National Agricultural Insurance Scheme (MNAIS). The Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana is a crop Insurance Scheme recently launched by Government of India. In Kerala, Paddy, banana and tapioca would be covered. The scale of assistance varies across districts, which is decided by the District Level Technical Committee. For the premium, the farmer has to pay a nominal share (i.e.) 1.5 - 2% for paddy and 5% for commercial crops. The remaining share is to be shared equally by Government of India and State Government. Apart from yield loss, the new scheme will cover post-harvest losses also. It will also provide farm level assistance for localized calamities including hailstorms, unseasonal rains, landslides and inundations.

Government have examined the proposal and requested Government of India to take urgent steps to limit only public sector insurance companies to participate in the tender process for Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana in the State of Kerala as per the letter read as 3rd paper above.

As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India have informed that in addition to the 11 Insurance Companies already empanelled for implementation of the scheme, 5 companies have been empanelled from current Kharif 2016 season onwards. Government have now decided to implement Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana in

the State limiting only the insurance companies empanelled as per the revised guidelines of Government of India to participate in the tender process.


