### Expression of Interest invited from Agencies for conducting study on identification of data gaps and building models for data on Sustainable Development

United Nations' declaration on 2030 agenda for Sustainable Development in 2015, which set 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and associated 169 targets to be achieved by the year 2030, having social, economic and environmental dimensions, was adopted by 193 member countries. In order to achieve 17 Goals and associated targets, 232 indicators were developed globally, which can be restructured according to each country's socio-economic-environmental dimensions that will eventually lead to achieving the targets and goals as envisaged by the United Nations. In India, the roles and responsibilities for implementation and monitoring of SDGs rest with NITI Aayog and Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI). As part of this, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) developed a National Indicator Framework (NIF) consisting of 306 indicators for monitoring the implementation of SDGs, which can be downloaded from: "[http://www.mospi.gov.in/sites/default/file/National\\_Indicator\\_Framework\\_6nov18.pdf](http://www.mospi.gov.in/sites/default/file/National_Indicator_Framework_6nov18.pdf)". As far as the State is concerned, some of the indicators may need modification and some new indicators may be introduced for achieving Agenda 2030. Planning and Economic Affairs (CPMU) Department, Government of Kerala is in the process of identifying data gaps for the national indicators at state level and sub-state levels (up to Grama Panchayat level) and exploring the possibilities of obtaining periodic data through various sources. In order to assess the data gaps fully and develop models for generating data for sustainable development, an exhaustive study is required.

Expression of interest (EoI) is invited from Consultancy Agencies

for identification of data gaps and developing models for generating data for indicators of sustainable development in the three dimensions, viz., Social (Goals 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 16), Economic (Goals 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11) and Environment (Goals 6, 12, 13, 14 and 15) separately, with necessary documents in support of the following:

1. Government Agencies/ Registered Institution / NGO with at least 10 years' experience in the field of undertaking surveys and studies in the respective areas (Social, Economic and Environmental)
2. Experience in undertaking Government (both State & Central) projects. List of surveys/studies/other initiatives are to be attached
3. Profile of the Agency with resume of the technical team collaborating with the project under reference.
4. Any accreditation by Kerala State Planning Board or Kerala Government or Central Government/Agencies
5. Any other documents in support of their core competency
